

# SPAIN-ANDALUCIA 7 DAYS / 6 NIGHTS MADRID-CORDOBA-SEVILLA—GRANADA-TOLEDO-MALAGA 20/08/25-26/08/25

### 1st DAY: 20/08/25 BEIRUT-MADRID-GRANADA

Meeting at the airport and flight to Madrid. Arrive in Madrid and departure to Granada. Granada is a city in southern Spain's Andalusia region, in the foothills of the Sierra Nevada mountains. It's known for grand examples of medieval architecture dating to the Moorish occupation, especially the Alhambra. This sprawling hilltop fortress complex encompasses royal palaces, serene patios, and reflecting pools from the Nasrid dynasty, as well as the fountains and orchards of the Generalife gardens. Check in at to the hotel dinner and overnight.



### 2<sup>nd</sup> DAY: 21/08/25 GRANADA-MALAGA-SEVILLA

Breakfast in our hotel. Today our city tour begins dominated by the exuberant beauty of the Alhambra - a masterpiece of art and unimaginable detail in the decoration, made of plaster, marble and brick, whose name is Arabic root meaning "red castle". Built on a stone hill, at the mouth of the River Darro, protected by mountains and surrounded by woods, among the oldest neighborhoods in the city, the Alhambra was originally designed for military area but since the mid13th century became the residence of kings. Continue to Malaga, which is the second-most populous city in Andalusia and the sixth most populous in the country. It lies in Southern Iberia on the Costa del Sol ("Coast of the Sun") of the Mediterranean, primarily in the left bank of the Guadalhorce. The urban core originally developed in the space between the Gibralfaro Hill and the Guadalmedina. Málaga's history spans about 2,800 years, making it one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in Western Europe. According to most scholars, it was founded about 770 BC by the Phoenicians from Tyre as Malaka. Continue to Sevilla, check in at the hotel, dinner and overnight.





### 3rd DAY: 22/08/25 SEVILLA

Breakfast in our hotel. During this morning our tour will be left to the charm of the city of Carmen, built on the banks of the Guadalquivir river. We wander the historic downtown, the famous Santa Cruz with its picturesque alleys, the balconies full of flowers and the most stylish Patty throughout Spain. We will visit the Cathedral of the city, third largest in the world, and will continue to visit Alkathar, the royal palace in Seville, which once had the intention to compete in beauty the famous Alhambra. The tour will conclude with a visit to two of the most impressive squares across the country, Square of Spain and the square of America.





At nigh we suggest you watch Flamengo dance in his homeland. Dinner and overnight.

### 4th DAY: 23/08/25 SEVILLA-CORDOBA-MADRID

Breakfast in our hotel. Departure to Cordoba. Cordoba is the city that was once the capital of the strongest kingdom of Islam, spiritual and administrative center, the most civilized capital in Europe. We wander through the picturesque streets of the Jewish Quarter where the soul of traditional Cordoba with its beautiful Patty. We will visit the city center, the magnificent Mosque Meskita, silent sanctuary today, with 850 red-white columns, arches and marble wood, stately remnant of the powerful Caliphate of Cordoba in the heart of which stands a Christian church. Continue to Madrid, check in at the hotel, dinner and overnight.



Breakfast in our hotel. Panoramic City tour in Madrid. Along the way you'll tour historic plazas like Plaza Mayor and Plaza de la Villa, see intriguing neighborhoods like Barrio de la Morería and view the city's grand boulevard. Before we end our tour we visit the famous Prado Museum. Return to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

### 6<sup>th</sup>DAY: 25/08/25 MADRID-TOLEDO

Breakfast in our hotel. Today we see the City of Three Cultures ", Toledo, a city with great historic, artistic and cultural heritage. We wander the narrow streets of the medieval city and visit the Cathedral, a unique building of great artists and a mixture of several architectural styles and the church of St. Thomas, where we admire the masterpiece of El Greco "The Burial of Count Orgaz". Return to Madrid, dinner and overnight.

#### 7th DAY: 26/08/25 MADRID-BEIRUT

Breakfast in our hotel. Free morning for shopping. Late noon transfer to Madrid airport for our flight back to Beirut.
